- Cultivate a culture of achievement and diversity.

Build school structures and support systems.

- Evaluate and align school structures and schedule.
- > Organize social networks and relationships.
- Target and scaffold language to support achievement.
- Plan and provide rigorous academic instruction.

Foster collaborative communities of learners.

- Support school-based teacher dialogue and learning.
- Enlist and engage multiple community stakeholders.
- Mutually collaborate with parents and families.
